1. Management and coordination

Project coordination

A Principal Investigator from the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology (MCAST), who leads the project scientific tasks and management, is responsible for the mandatory duties of project coordination.

• Project Meetings

The Executive Board (EB) held quarterly meetings. (Tab. 1). The EB guides the scientific and collaboration agenda of the project based on feedback received from the Project Officer (PO), General Assembly (GA) and the High Level Scientific Advisory Board (HLSAB). The HLSAB consists of eight high-level scientific experts not directly involved in the Project.

• Project Management Structures

The overall structure of the ReNature collaboration is described in Fig. 1. The GA and HLSAB oversaw project management-related activities and the general performance of the project.

• Project Quality Management

To assess the quality of the ReNature training, networking and clustering activities, we requested anonymous feedback from all event participants. This feedback was evaluated (Tab. 2), and considered when compiling Quality Assessment Reports, according to agreed quality indicators.
