In the context of the Horizon 2020 programme, the European Commission published a document titled "Guidelines on Open Access to Scientific Publications and Research Data in Horizon 2020". The document clearly describes the need that led to the mandate for open access to scientific publications, research data and their associated metadata that have been produced under funding from the Horizon 2020 programme.

In this context, Deliverable 7.2 "Data management plan" provides the plan for the management of research outcomes (and more specifically, the research data and its publication) that is produced during the ReNature project lifetime, as well as the project related information collected from the ReNature partners for the respective use cases. The document aims to ensure that the research activities of the project are compliant with the H2020 Open Access policy and the recommendations of the Open Research Data pilot. The project's DMP outlines how research data is collected, processed or generated both within the project and how this data will be curated and preserved during and after the project.

The DMP is a living document that will be updated whenever significant changes in the project require revisions or amendments and, moreover, in time with periodic project evaluations. The DMP has been developed in close collaboration with all consortium partners who provided information on their planned data collection, generation and processing as well as relevant institutional policies.
